Home Alone Guidelines Provided by DFACS

*Children 8 yrs old and younger should **never** be left home alone.

*Children between the ages of 9 & 12 may be left home alone for brief periods of time (less than 2 hours) when the child is determined to be mature by the caretaker.

*Children ages 13 and older may be left alone & may perform the role of babysitter as authorized by the parent/caretaker. Limit to 12 hours or less when the child is determined to be mature by the caretaker.

Attention Harmony Parents...

Please keep in mind the following policies when eating lunch with your child in the cafeteria: 1) all parents should sit with their child at the visitor's table, 2) other children may not be invited to sit with you and your child as we must ensure that there is room for all visiting parents and their children at the appropriate table, 3) the Federal School Lunch Program prohibits "fast food" and carbonated beverages at lunch time, therefore food may be purchased in the cafeteria or brought from home.
