Ecosystem- All the **living and nonliving** things in an environment and all their interactions.

Community-All the living things in an ecosystem.

Population-All the members of a **single type** of organism in an ecosystem.

Habitat- The **home** of a living thing.

Organism- Any **living** thing.

Natural Resource- A **material** on Earth that is **necessary or useful** to people.

Environment- The things that make up an area, such as **land, water, and air**.

Shelter-A **place** or object that **protects** an animal and keeps it safe.

Endangered Species- Animals and plants that are **close to becoming extinct**; having very few of its kind left.

Weathering-The **process** that causes rocks to crumble, crack, and break. Ex. The effects of water and wind on rocks.

Pollution- The adding of **harmful** substances to the water, air, or land.
