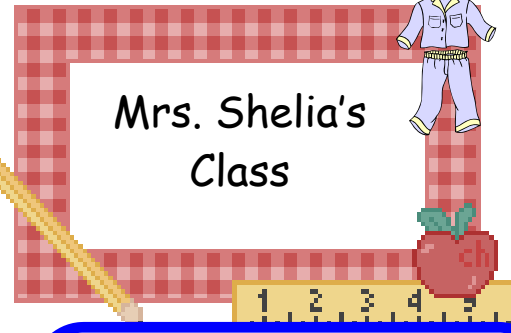

Many of the AKS in kindergarten are ongoing. These are the ones that we are focusing on currently

## MATH: Number Sense

- 28 identify penny, nickel, dime, quarter and dollar and tell values
- 29 count out pennies to buy items that together cost 30 cents or less
- 42 name days/months/seasons
- 20 demonstrate 1 to 1 correspondence
- 21 produce models for number words to ten
- 23 recognize/write numerals through 20 to label sets
- 24 ordinal numbers

## LANGUAGE ARTS

### Listening/Speaking/Viewing

- 10 complete sentences when speaking/begin to use subject/verb agreement and tense

### Reading

#### Making connections to books read/heard

- 24 differences in letters, words and sentences

### Word Study

- 32 recognizing words in context
- 35 rhyming/ non-rhyming words
- 45 pictiary/dictionary

### Writing

- 51 rereads story to revise/edit
- 55 capitalize the pronoun "I," beginning letter of sentences, and proper nouns (such as personal names and months)
- 59 write a piece that involves one topic
- 60 drawings, letters, phonetically spelled words to share information

### Science

#### day/night sky

- 7time patterns and objects in the day and night sky (sun, moon, stars)
- 7b classify objects according to those seen in the day/night sky
- 7c explain that the sun applies heat and light to Earth
- 7a describe changes that occur in the sky during the day/night, and as day turns to night



PLEASE be working on sight words. See if your child can read 30 sight words. The Foothold words given earlier are a good place to start. Also practice reading color words and number words for sight words.
